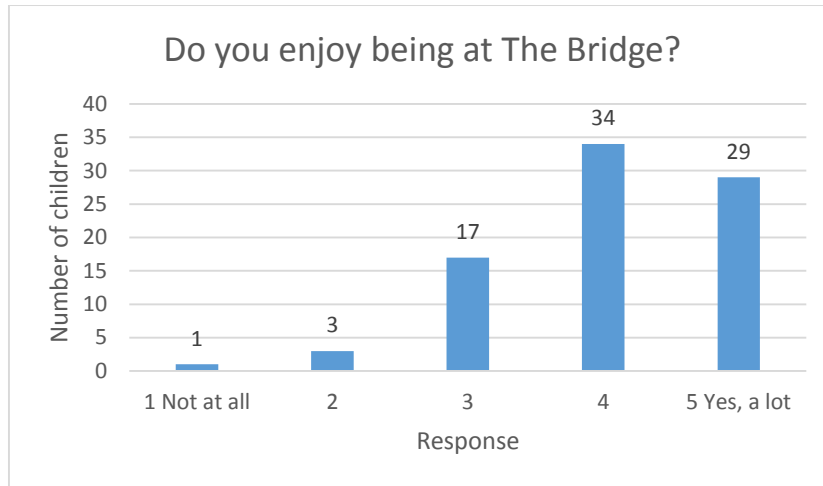


Question number 1:

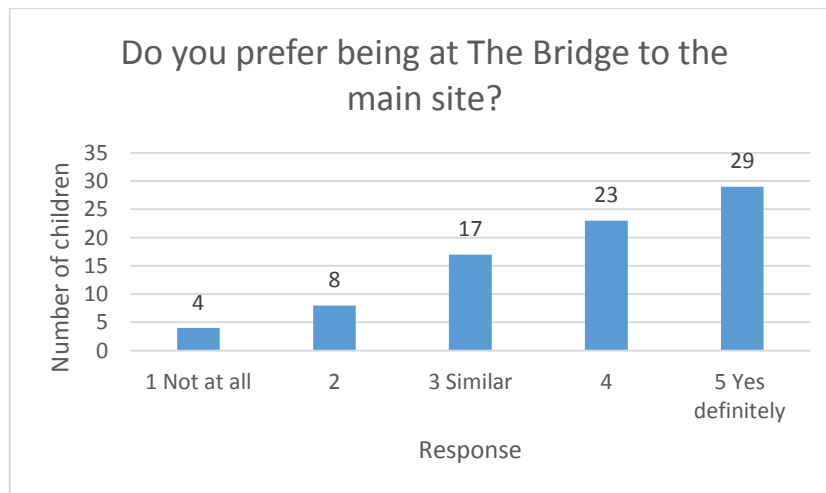
84 children answered



75% of the children who answered either gave a scoring of 4 or 5 for this question.

Question number 2:

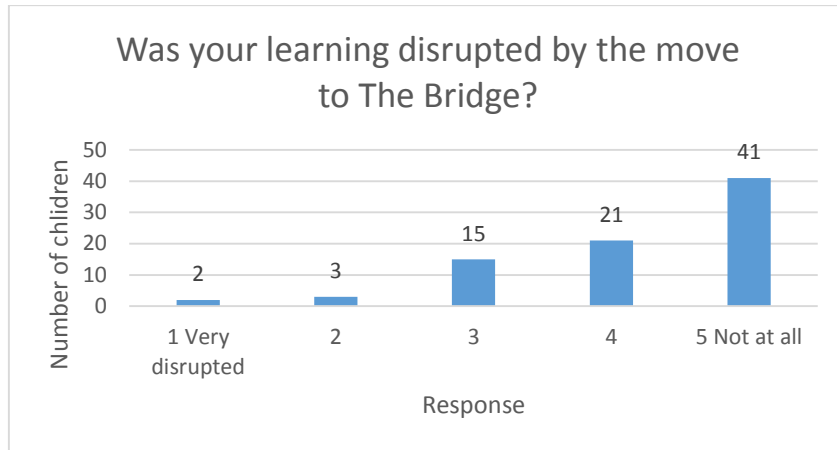
81 children answered



64% of the children gave a score of 4 or 5 to this question. 17 children said similar.

Question number 3:

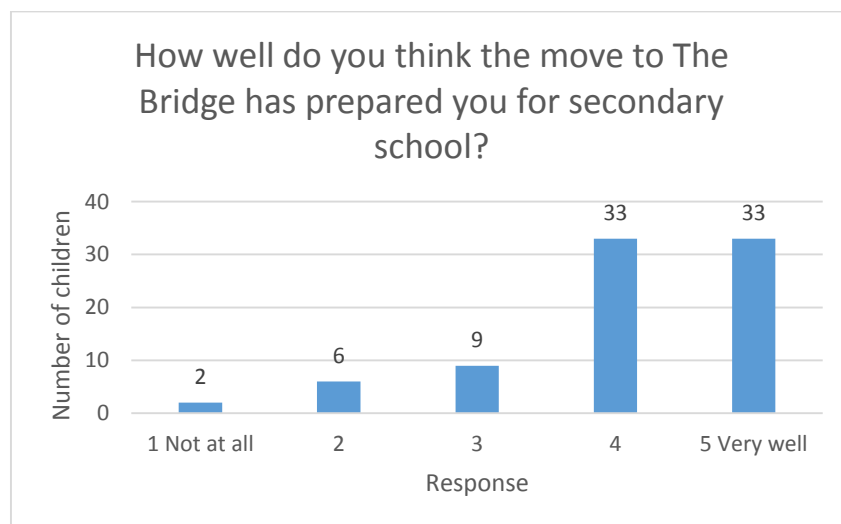
82 children answered



76% of children scored this question a 4 or 5.

Question number 4:

83 children answered



80% of children gave this question a score of 4 or 5.

Overall, the answers to these questions were very positive, with the majority of children scoring highly. Most children enjoy being at the Bridge and prefer it to the main site; most children also felt that their learning wasn't disrupted very much by the move and feel better prepared for secondary school.
