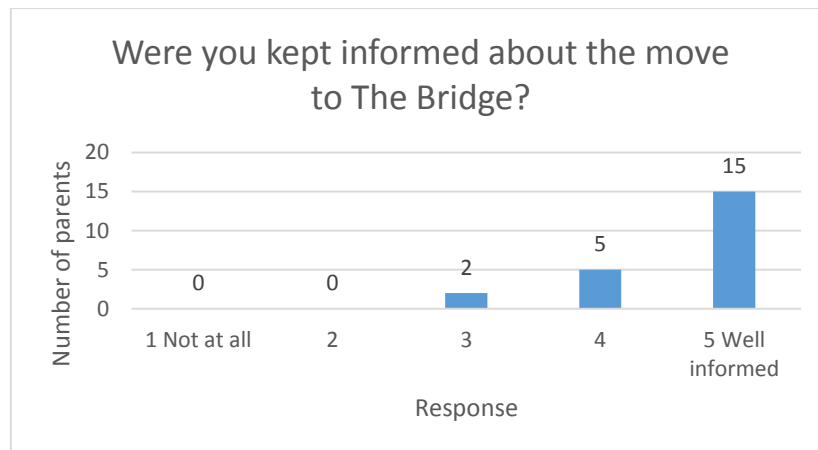


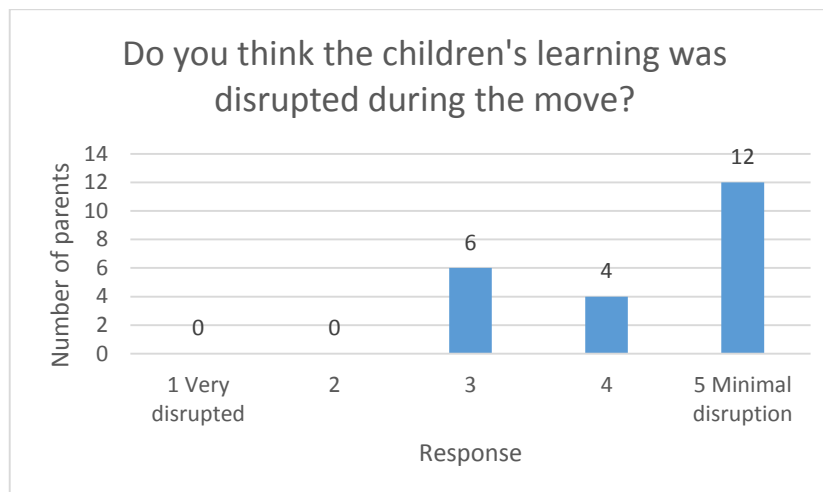
The Bridge – Parent’s Survey – July 2017

Question number 1: 22 parents answered



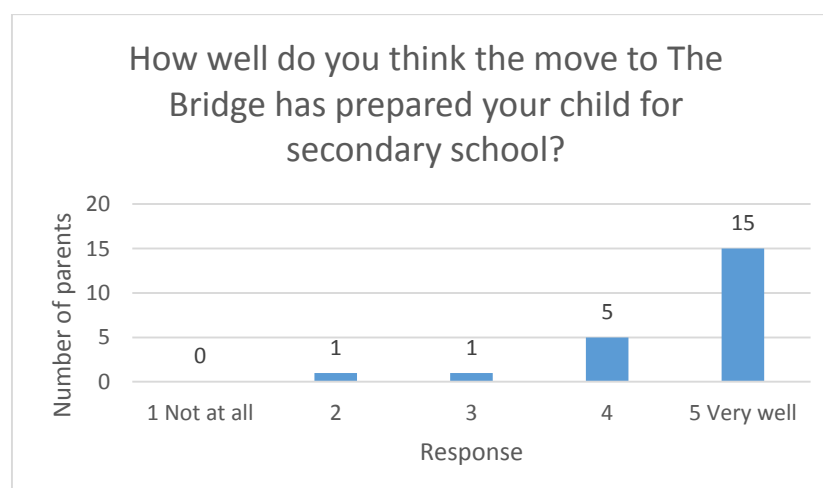
91% of the parents who answered either gave a scoring of 4 or 5 for this question.

Question number 2: 22 parents answered



73% of the parents who answered gave a score of 4 or 5 to this question.

Question number 3: 22 parents answered



91% of the parents who answered either gave a scoring of 4 or 5 for this question.

Question number 4: 22 parents answered



59% of the parents who answered either gave a scoring of 4 or 5 for this question.

Overall, the answers to these questions were very positive, with the majority of parents scoring highly. The majority of parents who answered the survey felt that the move to The Bridge had helped prepare their children for secondary school, with minimal disruption to learning and that they were kept well informed.

More parents answered more negatively for question 4 – they felt their children didn’t feel part of Newbridge being on a separate site. This is something which should improve as we develop more ways for the main site and The Bridge to work together in the upcoming year.
