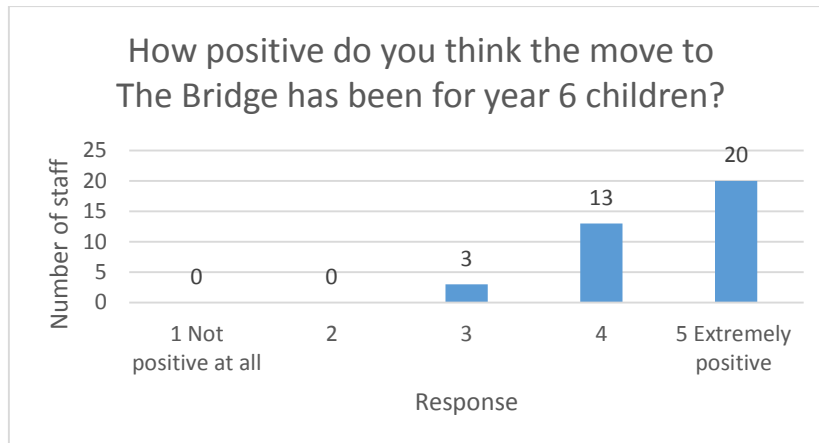




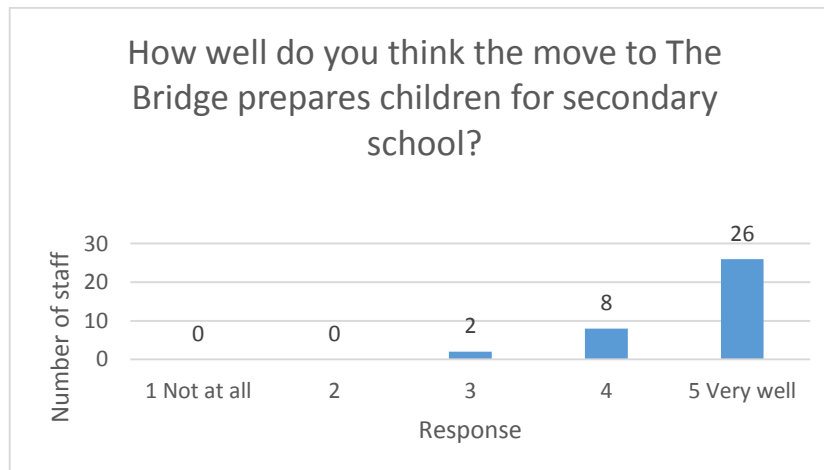
The Bridge – Staff Survey – July 2017

Question number 1: 36 members of staff answered



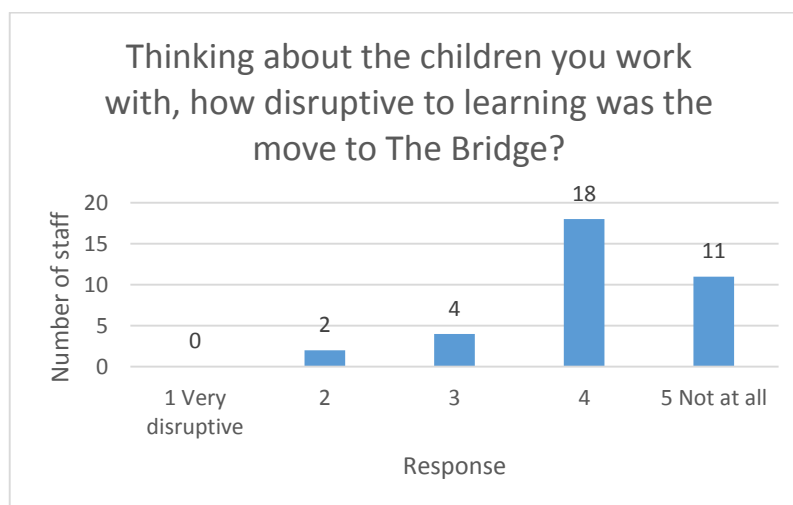
92% of the staff who answered either gave a scoring of 4 or 5 for this question.

Question number 3: 35 members of staff answered



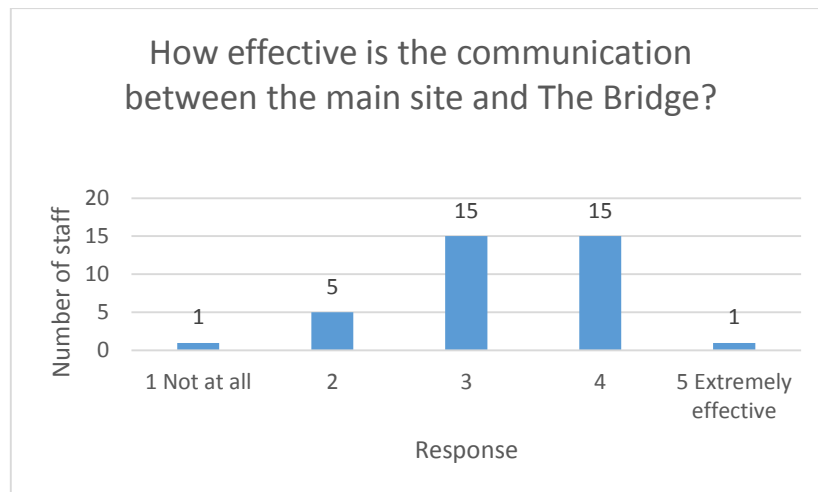
83% of the staff who answered either gave a scoring of 4 or 5 for this question.

Question number 4:

37 members of staff answered



43% of the staff who answered either gave a scoring of 4 or 5 for this question.

57% of the staff scored this question 3 or lower.

The survey shows that the majority of staff see the move to The Bridge as a positive one for the children, which prepares them well for secondary school. The majority of staff thought that there was minimal disruption to the learning of the children during the move.

For question 4, more staff answered negatively – they feel that communication between the two sites could be more effective. This will be worked on next year, with increased use of the school calendar and staff being reminded to use the bags, which are taken between sites. All staff need to be proactive in replying to emails and visiting either site if they need to meet with someone in order to ensure communication is improved.
