**Maths:**

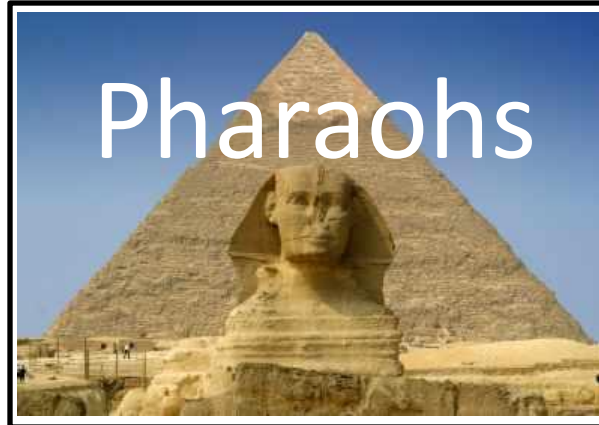
- Angles

# Things to explore with your child!

## PE:

## Home Learning:

## Reading:

## Writing:

Research the discovery of Tutankhamun so your child has as many facts as possible for their report.

Discuss one of your child's favourite stories – could you have a go at turning it into a play script?

## Maths:

Help children learn their times tables by practising as often as possible. Ask the children to teach you one of the times table games we play in school! Ask your children to tell you the time at different points of the day. Use your TV guide – how long is this programme on for? What time does the next programme start?

## Science:

We will be undertaking lots of different experiments in science this half term.
